Current reimbursement rates for life sustaining oxygen equipment fail to factor the increased costs and must be addressed to preserve access to care






Percent of Increased Costs Incurred¹

Incurred increased oxygen equipment costs in the last 12 months




Received advance notice or expectation of O2 cost increase this year



CONTINUED MARKET CHALLENGES WITH SUPPLY CHAIN DISRUPTION & INCREASE SHIPPING COSTS¹
