


## COST INCREASES AFFECTING OSTOMY & UROLOGICAL SUPPLIES

Current reimbursement rates for ostomy & urological supplies fail to factor the increased costs and *must be addressed to preserve* access to care

## POTENTIAL IMPACT ON HME PROVIDERS:


Up to 20%+	increased shipping costs

## CONTINUED MARKET CHALLENGES WITH SUPPLY CHAIN DISRUPTION & INCREASED SHIPPING COSTS<sup>1</sup>

Respondents report supply chain, inflation, labor market, and challenges managing operational costs as issues negatively impacting their ability to provide disposable supplies
